The development department within Inhealthcare is responsible for producing high quality software to support the Inhealthcare business. The successful candidate will be responsible for planning, building, and executing repeatable tests to ensure the software meets the requirements.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Duties will include, but are not restricted to, the following:

- Test Execution
 - Manage test cycles and execute test cases, and ensure the detection and recording of as many defects as possible in each project.
 - Review and manage logged defects, carry out analysis on defect clustering, and perform confirmation testing.
 - Participate in lessons learnt sessions.
- Test Preparation
 - Review user stories and product backlog during sprints.
 - Review project documentation (requirements, mock-ups, etc.).
 - Assist the test lead in testing the project documentation and creating a test basis.
- Test Planning
 - Be able to plan own workload according to project timelines.
 - Design and write test plans and test cases as directed by the test lead.
- Adherence to InTechnology's ISO9001 and 27001 accreditation standards.

TECHNICAL SKILLS

The ideal candidate will have some technical knowledge and be familiar with some software testing methodologies, although this role is also suitable to someone with no experience but who has an attention to detail, a commitment to quality and standards, and who can learn quickly and take the initiative.



A candidate must be able to demonstrate:

- An ability to manage and test several projects in parallel.
- An ability to write comprehensive test plans, test scripts, and defect reports, and communicate test results.
- An understanding of different testing techniques, for example integration testing, load testing, regression testing, smoke testing, system testing, and user acceptance testing.
- An eye for detail and commitment to quality.

The following skills/ experience would be an advantage, but are not essential:

- Knowledge of Atlassian tools, particularly JIRA and Confluence.
- Understanding of HTML and CSS
- Tablet/mobile based platforms such as iOS, Android, and Windows.

PERSON SPECIFICATION

The ideal candidate will be able to demonstrate the following skills, attributes and experience:

- An intelligent self-starter with the ability to work on their own initiative to solve problems.
- Ability to work to tight timescales.
- A fast learner with the ability to pick up new skills quickly.
- Must be flexible and work as part of a team.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Ability to effectively communicate, co-ordinate, and work with other departments.
- Attention to detail.
- Good organizational skills.
- Ability to effectively pass on knowledge to other people.
